- Economic Policy (including labour market, industrial, and regional policies)
- Economic Problems and Performance (including macro/micro economics and finance)
- Greece, Southeast Europe and the European Union (including economic and political cooperation and energy)
- Migration and Minorities
- History and Culture
- State and Society

The closing date for receipt of the 'Abstract Submission Form' is 19:00 (UK Time) on 19 February 2019.
